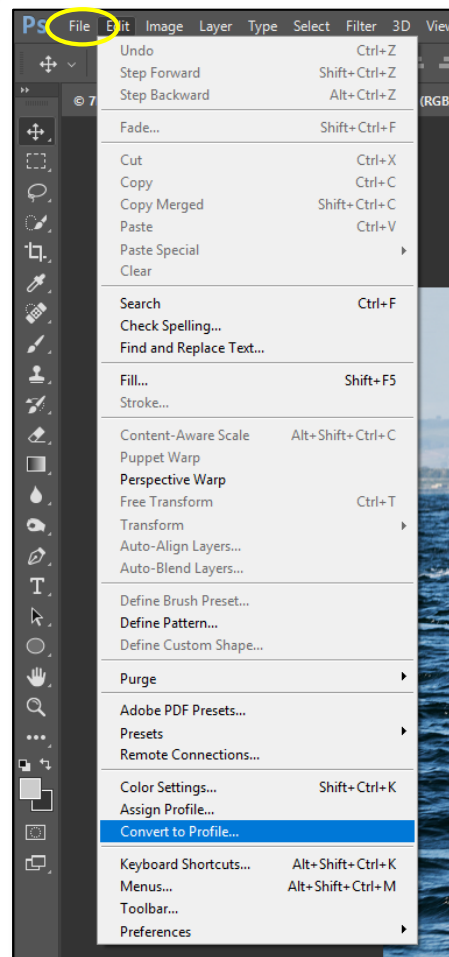


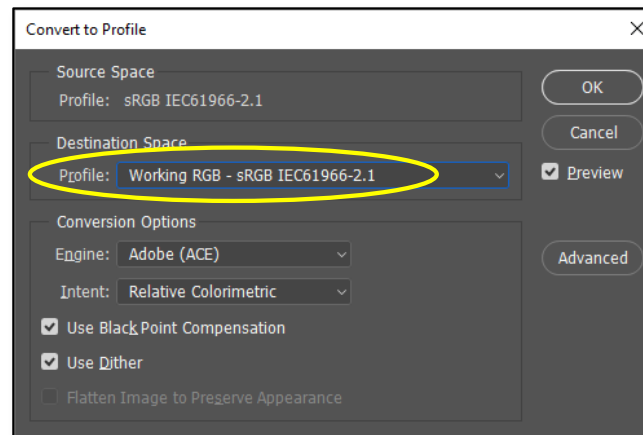
Setting the Colour Space to sRGB

The *Colour Space* affects how your image will look on various outlets including the internet. *sRGB* is the Space that is most widely supported and is fairly standard nowadays. This quick tutorial shows how to change to this Colour Space.

1 Click on File >> Convert to Profile.



2 From the list of available Profiles, select the one shown below.



If the *Dialogue Box* does not look similar to the diagram shown on the left, it may be that you are in *Advanced* mode. If so, this button will show '*Basic*', click it to set the same as this diagram.

Click OK to effect the Profile.

Convert to Profile maintains the vast majority of the original colours on conversion and is the recommended method.

Assign to Profile does not convert the colours in the image and may dramatically change the appearance of the colours in the photograph.
